



Applebee's offers a turnkey program called Flapjack Fundraiser which is easy to execute and can provide much needed funds for your organization.

The Flapjack Fundraisers are scheduled only on Saturdays from 8:00a.m.-10:00a.m. on a first come first served basis. There are two seating times for the event – 8:00a.m.-9:00a.m. and 9:00a.m.-10:00a.m. Please make sure not to sell more than 200 tickets per seating. Your organization will receive a ticket template to reproduce. The front is the actual ticket and the back is a coupon for your guests to use on their next visit to Applebee's. You will need to print the tickets double-sided. There are two options for ticket sales: a \$5.00 ticket value with \$1.00 of each ticket sold that goes back to the restaurant to cover food and labor costs or a \$7.50 ticket value with \$2.50 of each ticket sold given back to the restaurant to cover food and labor costs. This money is to be given in cash to the manager on duty at the time of the event. Your organization will keep the rest of the profits! We ask that you conduct sales of tickets prior the event date only. No tickets will be sold at the door the day of the event. With the \$5.00 ticket value, we will provide pancakes, syrup, butter, china, silverware, cups, and napkins. With the \$7.50 ticket value, we will provide pancakes, syrup, butter, sausage links, tea, coffee, juice, sodas, china, silverware, cups, and napkins. Your group will be responsible for greeting, serving, and cleaning up after your guests. You will need to bring an adequate amount of volunteers from your organization to help facilitate the event. Applebee's currently hosts these events at the Cartersville, Rome, Hiram, West Cobb, Sugar Hill, Douglasville, Griffin, Kennesaw (Town Center), Stockbridge, LaGrange, Decatur (Memorial Drive), Jonesboro, and Atlanta (Cascade Road) locations only.
